

DRESS CODE GOLF ATTIRE

The dress code of the Club provides for the appropriate dress required in the various areas of the Clubhouse and the golf course. The following definitions set out two different types of dress and describes the various standards required in the rooms of the Clubhouse. Standards of dress apply at all times and this standard dictates that "jeans" are not permitted in any area of the Club or golf course and footwear must be worn at all times. Caps must be worn with the peaks forward. Shirts must be tucked in at all times except those designed to be worn out.

Advertising of any form is not permitted other than the subtle display of logos or brand and company names that normally appear on golf wear. If you are unsure as to the dress code you may contact the Pro Shop or the General Manager concerning golf attire.

ALL MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS ARE REQUIRED TO APPEAR PROPERLY DRESSED ON THE CLUB PROPERTY AT ALL TIMES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DRESS CODE

PARKING LOT

Members and Guests are not permitted to change clothing or shoes in the parking lot. Changing must take place in the appropriate locker room. Use of the disabled stalls is limited to those possessing and displaying an appropriate Disabled Parking Permit _

Gentlemen

Dress allowed would be suitable golf shirts with collar or turtleneck. Golf shirts must be tucked in at all times. Members may wear any make of sockettes, ankle socks or executive length knee socks with tailored bermuda shorts that are no more that 4" above the knee. "Cargo" style shorts or pants are not permitted. Turned down sport socks do not qualify as sockettes. Short shorts, cut-offs, tank tops, t-shirts, jeans and calf length sport socks with shorts are prohibited at all times anywhere on the property. Men's headgear must not be worn in the Clubhouse, other than in the locker rooms and the Pro Shop. Shoes must be worn at all times.

Ladies

Dress allowed would be suitable golf shirts with tailored shorts or skirts, that are no more than 4" above the knee, slacks or capris with a choice of sockettes, ankle socks or executive length knee socks. "Cargo" style shorts or pants are not permitted. Sleeveless golf shirts must have a collar. Golf shirts must be

tucked in at all times except those designed to be worn out. Short shorts, jeans, cut-offs, tank tops, halter tops and bare midriffs are prohibited.

Juniors

Junior members are required to comply with the foregoing as appropriate.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE DEPARTMENT

The Patio Room, Lower Patio, Norm Smith Lounge, and the Men's Lounge are available to all PrivateClubConnect members. Please note that York Downs members pay an annual food & beverage fee, which allows our members to receive lower prices on all food and beverage items.

CLUBHOUSE
